# **About Methodology**

This book contains all titles and abstracts of presented papers. To facilitate research we have created several methods of locating information.

## **Symposia**

Papers are presented by chronological order of Symposium and by Session. At the beginning, only one Session was dedicated to the History of Rockets and Rocketry. Then, from 1983, faced with an increasing number of papers submitted, two sessions were regularly organized. This interest in the history of space activities continued to grow leading to an increasing number of papers. From 1995, three sessions became necessary to accommodate them.

For each paper we have indicated, in addition to the IAF/IAA numbers,\* a volume reference in the American Astronautical Society (AAS) History Series proceedings volumes.

We have tried to list each paper by the main period it covers. When the paper covers a large period - i.e. a general survey of an activity - we have placed it in the earliest period it covers. We have grouped the papers in three main categories:

20th Century, itself subdivided into three sub-categories:

Before 1945

After 1945 and Before 1957

After 1957, which marks the beginning of the "Space Era."
